

# **ATP Science receives \$302,400 penalty from the TGA**

The infringement notices are for the alleged advertising of a number of therapeutic goods not included in the Australian Register of Therapeutic Goods.

The TGA alleges that ATP Science made a number of claims in relation to the goods, including prohibited representations relating to cancer and the treatment of mental health conditions, along with restricted representations.

The use of prohibited and restricted representations in advertisements for therapeutic products is unlawful without the express permission of the TGA.
